

School District of West Salem Notice of Educational Options and Accountability Report (per Wisconsin Statute 118.57)

According to Wisconsin Statute 118.57, every year, the School District of West Salem is required to publish a class 1 notice describing all educational options available to children who reside in the district, as well as notification about the school district's accountability report.
